The Art Studio Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree prepares you for a career in the visual arts or for transfer to a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) program. The Art Studio A.F.A. degree prepares you for a career in the visual arts or for transfer to a Bachelor of Fine Arts (B.F.A.) program. Both degrees are Tennessee Transfer Pathways (TTP). TTPs enable you to complete your degree at Motlow and then transfer to any Tennessee public university, and several Tennessee private universities, to complete your bachelor's degree.

These programs provide the skills necessary to be successful in the field of art. Build confidence in your abilities and the quality of your professional portfolios. Participate in rigorous problem solving and conceptual assignments to develop critical thinking and aesthetic understanding skills. Studio Art is designed to teach you the history, skills, and creative processes of professional artists.
