

## GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDANCE OF SPECTATORS AT OUTDOOR ATHLETIC EVENTS ON MOTLOW COLLEGE'S CAMPUSES AND APPROVED ATHLETIC SITES

## Attendance of spectators is allowed for Motlow State outdoor athletic events.

In accordance with CDC guidance, When You've Been Fully Vaccinated | CDC, fully vaccinated individuals are not required to wear masks on TBR or Motlow State Community College campuses.

TBR and Motlow State Community College recommend that those individuals who have not been vaccinated do so as soon as possible.

TBR and Motlow State Community College highly encourage those who have not been fully vaccinated to continue to wear a mask and to engage in social distancing, both to protect themselves and others.

Protecting the health and safety of the Motlow community and the communities at large is a Motlow priority. Therefore, spectators must comply with all Motlow, CDC, and state guidelines.

## Before you attend

- Stay home if you are sick.
- Stay home if you have symptoms, if you are waiting for COVID-19 test results, or if you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.
- Stay home if you are at increased risk for severe illness, have an existing medical condition, or need to take extra precautions.
- Stay home if you live with or regularly interact with someone who is at increased risk of severe illness from COVID-19.
